

Panel Design Instructions

Below is the procedure to help you design your themed showcase for the CVQ 2017 Quilt Show.

1. Choose a theme for your showcase.
2. Decide which quilts you would like to include in your showcase.
3. Determine whether you want to have a one-, two- or three-panel showcase. Download and print the showcase panel layout sheets. You will need one, two or three sheets, depending on the number of panels in your showcase.
4. Draw each quilt or cut out colored paper to represent each quilt and create a pleasing layout. Each square on the layout panel represents 1 foot. Each panel in your showcase will be 6' wide and 8' high.
5. A one-panel showcase will be measure 6 ft. wide x 8 ft. high.
A two-panel showcase will use two panels, each measuring 6 ft. wide x 8 ft. high.
A three-panel showcase will use three panels, each measuring 6 ft. wide x 8 ft. high.
6. Submit a registration form for each quilt being shown by **August 8th, 2017**. Include a photo with each quilt you submit. Submit the forms in person to Laura Murphy or by email to CVQ.quilt.show@gmail.com.
7. Deliver your quilts at one of the Acquisition dates: Sat, Sept 2, 10 am to 1 pm, Sun, Sept. 3, noon to 3:30 pm, Wed, Sept. 6, 5 pm to 8 pm. More details to follow.
