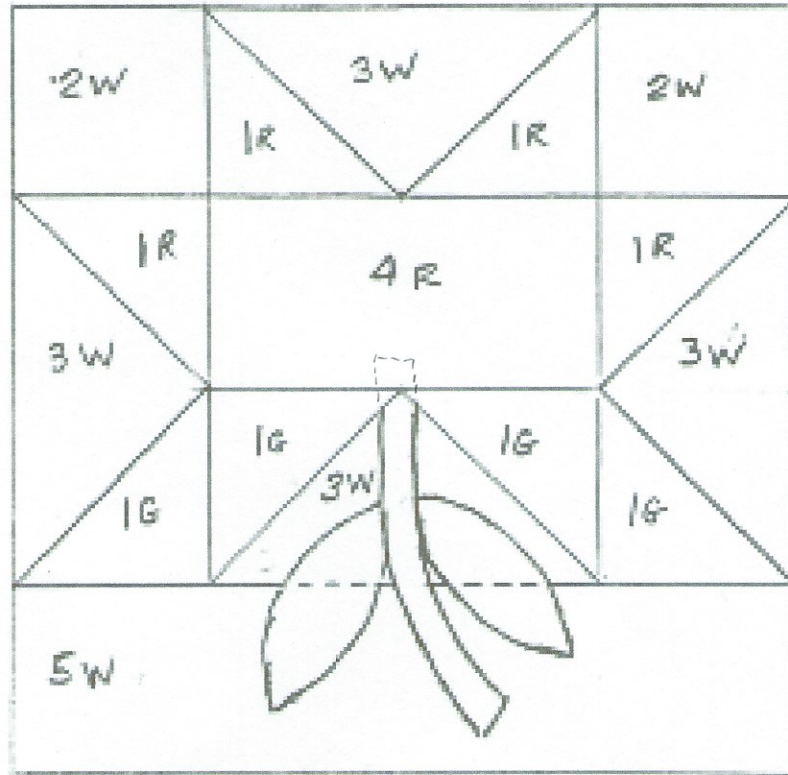
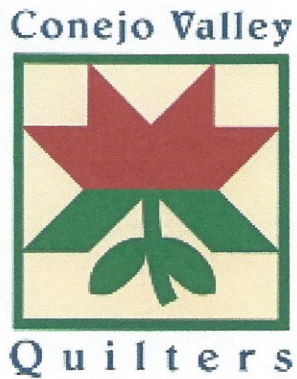


CONEJO VALLEY QUILTERS GUILD LOGO BLOCK

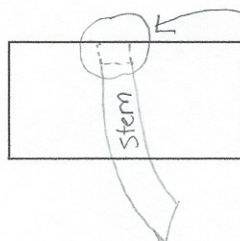


4" BLOCK

The cutting instructions assume the "flip and sew" method of constructing the flying geese units. Other methods can be used but the cutting should be modified accordingly. If using fusible appliqué the pattern needs to be reversed.

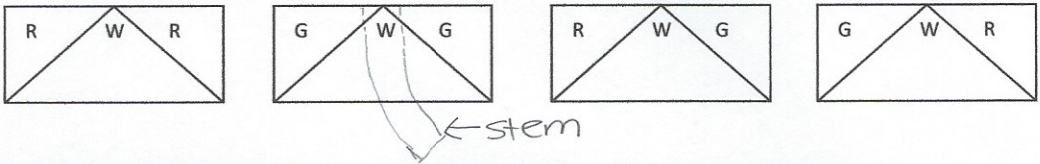
Color Key	Cutting Quantity	Cutting Instructions for <u>4" block</u> Size and shape	Cutting Instructions for <u>6" block</u> Size and shape
R = red fabric	1 4	1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle (4R) 1-1/2" squares (1R)	2" x 3-1/2" rectangle (4R) 2" squares (1R)
G = green fabric	4 1	1-1/2" squares (1G) See diagram above for stem and leaves (add seam allowance for turned edge appliqué)	2" squares (1G) Diagram for stem and leaves on pg 2 (add seam allowance for turned edge appliqué)
W = white fabric	2 4 1	1-1/2" squares (2W) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle (3W) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle (5W)	2" squares (2W) 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle (3W) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangle (5W)

Step 1: Attach top one-half inch of appliqué stem to one of the white (3W) pieces using any appliqué method. The stem and leaves appliqué will be attached when the block is complete.








Attach here

Step 2: Make 4 Flying Geese units. Each is a different color combination:

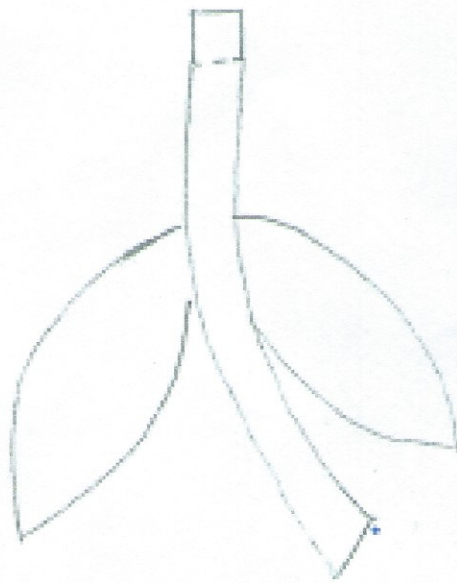
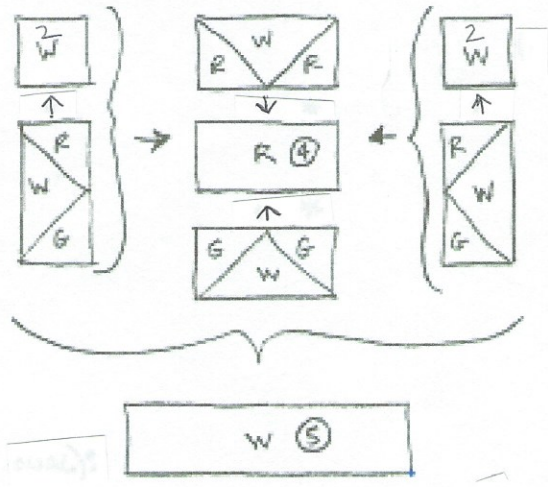


Instructions for the "flip and sew" method to make flying geese units:

<p>a) Draw a diagonal line on the back of each square:</p> 	<p>b) With right sides together, align one marked square (1R or 1G) with one edge of the rectangle (3W). Stitch one thread width to the outside of the diagonal line:</p> 
<p>c) Cut 1/4" away from the stitching line as shown. Discard small triangles or save for another use.</p> 	<p>d) Press the piece open.</p> 
<p>e) Repeat steps a) - d) on the other side of the rectangle (3W) to finish the unit:</p> 	

Step 3: Sew the block together according to the diagram. Be sure to keep the bottom of the stem out of the way of the seam when attaching piece 5W to the rest of the unit.

For 6" block, use this stem and leaves diagram:



Step 4: Add the appliqué leaves and complete the stem appliqué.
