

Supply List for MEDIUM Size Crimson & Clover Train Case

Crimson & Clover Train Case Pattern available from Sew Sweetness at

Fabric	1/2 yard exterior fabric 1 yard lining fabric 1 fat quarter for piping (optional)
Interfacing	1 1/4 yards of 20" wide lightweight fusible interfacing 1/2 yard of foam batting, either sew-in or single-sided fusible foam batting <i>(note: do not use double-sided fusible foam batting)</i> 1/4 yard extra-heavy sew-in interfacing (like Pellon #70 Peltex)
Notions	26" or longer purse zipper (zippers can be cut to size in class) (zipper should be a nylon coil, double-pull, in color to match exterior fabric) 9" regular zipper to match lining 1/4" wide fusible tape (like Steam-A-Seam or Wonder Tape) (omit if you are not using piping) Optional for piping: 2 yards of 5/32" cotton cording (find in drapery notions)
Equipment	Clover Wonder Clips (optional, or use heavy duty long pins) Heavy duty long pins Hand sewing needle for finishing #90 sewing machine needle Thread Scissors Rotary cutter and mat Fabric marker Zipper foot Sewing machine in good working order

MEDIUM TRAIN CASE CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Note: these instructions are slightly different from the pattern.

From the exterior fabric, cut:

- (1) Exterior Panel A, 28-1/4" x 1-1/2"
- (1) Exterior Panel B, 28-1/4" x 4-1/2"
- (2) Exterior Main Panel, using the Main Panel pattern piece (medium), cut on the fold
- (1) Handle, 7" x 5"
- (1) Exterior Zipper Tab, 1-1/2" x 4-1/2"

From the lining fabric, cut:

- (1) Lining Panel A, 28-1/4" x 1-1/2"
- (1) Lining Panel B, 28-1/4" x 4-1/2"
- (2) Lining Pocket, 28-1/4" x 4"
- (2) Lining Main Panel, using the Main Panel pattern piece (medium), cut on the fold
- (2) Zipper Panel A, 9-1/4" x 1-1/2"
- (2) Zipper Panel B, 9-1/4" x 6-1/4"
- (1) Lining Zipper Tab, 1-1/2" x 4-1/2"
- (2) Pocket Tab, 1-1/2" x 3"

From the fat quarter piping fabric (omit if you are not using piping), cut:

Cut 1-1/2" strips on a 45 degree angle, sew together at 90 degree angle at short ends until you have two 27-1/4" pieces

From the lightweight fusible interfacing, cut:

- (1) Lining Panel A, 28-1/4" x 1-1/2"
- (1) Lining Panel B, 28-1/4" x 4-1/2"
- (2) Lining Main Panel, using the Main Panel pattern piece (medium), cut on the fold
- (1) Handle, 7" x 5"
- (1) Zipper Tab, 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" (for Lining Zipper Tab)

Do not use interfacing on the Lining Zipper Panels

From the Soft and Stable, cut:

- (1) Exterior Panel A, 28-1/4" x 1-1/2"
- (1) Exterior Panel B, 28-1/4" x 4-1/2"
- (2) Exterior Main Panel, using the Main Panel pattern piece (medium), cut on the fold
- (1) Zipper Tab Insert, 1-1/2" x 3-1/2"

From the optional Peltex, cut 2 from the Main Panel pattern piece; trim 1/2" off all sides to reduce bulk in the seam (set aside)

MEDIUM TRAIN CASE INTERFACING BASTING / FUSING INSTRUCTIONS

Note: these instructions are slightly different from the pattern.

If you are using **sew-in foam batting**, baste foam batting to the following pieces only, using a 1/8" seam:

- (1) Exterior Panel A, 28-1/4" x 1-1/2"
- (1) Exterior Panel B, 28-1/4" x 4-1/2"
- (2) Exterior Main Panels, using the Main Panel pattern piece (medium), cut on the fold

Do not baste to Exterior Zipper Tab (1-1/2" x 4-1/2")

Sew Sweetness Tip: *Helpful Hint: I like to gently pull my fabric taut as I am basting it to the Soft and Stable for a tight, crisp finish. If you would like, machine quilt the Soft and Stable pieces at this time.*

If you are using **single-sided fusible foam batting**, fuse foam batting to the following pieces:

- (1) Exterior Panel A, 28-1/4" x 1-1/2"
- (1) Exterior Panel B, 28-1/4" x 4-1/2"
- (2) Exterior Main Panels, using the Main Panel pattern piece (medium), cut on the fold

Do not fuse to Exterior Zipper Tab (1-1/2" x 4-1/2")

Fuse the **lightweight fusible interfacing** to the following pieces:

- (1) Lining Panel A, 28-1/4" x 1-1/2"
- (1) Lining Panel B, 28-1/4" x 4-1/2"
- (2) Lining Main Panels, using the Main Panel pattern piece (medium), cut on the fold
- (1) Handle, 7" x 5"
- (1) Zipper Tab, 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" (fuse to Lining Zipper Tab only)

Do not use interfacing on the Lining Zipper Panels
